Choose one of the tasks from the below grid each week and complete, adding a note or a copy of the work that you have done to your homework books. Homework books will be checked each week, please ensure that these are kept in book bags.

RE	Pentecost falls in this half term. Think about how the Holy Spirit lives in you – how do you spread the message of Jesus? Complete a random act of kindness – what did you do?	History	What more would you like to learn? Take some time to complete some further research on the Egyptians and something which sparks your interest. Would you like to learn more about Tutankhamun, the way the Egyptians wrote (hieroglyphics), the river Nile and its importance or pyramids. Get creative and share your learning with me – what about creating a model or some artwork?
English	Can you write a set of instructions to make a sandwich, brush your teeth or play your favourite game? Don't forget to include a 'what you will need' list and the method and remember to be bossy!	Art/DT	Our topic this half term is water. Can you create a water image using any media you like. You may wish to take inspiration from the artists we are studying or go and visit a river/coastal area near us and create some artwork based on your observations there.
Maths	Practise telling the time whenever you can! Can you practise telling the time to o'clock and half past, quarter to and quarter past? What about to the nearest 5 minutes? Practise with someone at home at different times throughout the day.	Music	Can you create your own musical instrument using natural materials and have a go at composing something of your own?

	Don't forget that you should continue to access TTRockstars a little and often to support with the learning of your times tables. (Y2 should focus on 2's, 5's and 10's, Y3 should be learning their 3's, 4's and 8's)		
Science	Go on a light hunt around your home, what sources of light can you find? Are they natural or artificial sources of light? Take your learning outside and draw around your shadow at different parts of the day, how does it change? Why does this happen?	PE	It's time to get active. Reading

Thank you for the effort that you put into reading with your child/ren at home. This is the key to developing skills across the curriculum and the more you can do, the more your child will be able to use these skills in all areas of their learning. Remember to talk to your child about what they are reading as well as listening to them – the type of questions that need an explanation should be combined with fact finding questions. Reading books will continue to be changed in class on a Monday and we will also visit the Library each week to bring home a book to simply enjoy with you at home. Our Reading Suitcase will continue to visit each of us this half term where the children are encouraged to pop away their school readers for the night, curl up with Paddington Bear and a hot chocolate and enjoy reading for pleasure. Bookbags should be brought to school each day.

Uniform Reminder

Please could you ensure that <u>all</u> uniform including jumpers and ties, PE kits, lunch boxes, water bottles and coats etc. are named.

<u>Snacks</u>

Fruit is provided in class for snacks during morning playtime.
